NOTICE OF FORTHCOMING GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS

Dear Colleagues in IBD!

Notice is hereby given that the following positions on the Governing Board of ECCO are open for election:

ECCO President-Elect 2023-2025

The ECCO Governing Board is implementing § 5.3.4.1 of the ECCO Statutes by giving notice at least 12 weeks prior to the General Assembly, taking place on Thursday, March 2, 2023 at the ECCO'23 in Copenhagen where the election will take place. Voting will be by ballot, by simple majority rule.

Tasks:

1. The President-Elect will make every effort to assist ECCO in achieving its mission and objectives (see also §5.3.2.).
2. The President-Elect makes himself/herself cognisant with the overall lines of policy and directions of ECCO and assists the President in conducting the business of ECCO and official representation of ECCO.
3. The President-Elect serves on the Governing Board for two years as President-Elect; followed by two years as President and two years as Past-President.
4. In the event of incapacity of the President, the President-Elect assumes the role of President and represents the association.

Eligibility: Any Regular Member of ECCO in good standing who has served as an ECCO Committee member in the past and/or present can stand for election unless he/she holds a current position in industry or is a President or Past-President.

Term of office: ECCO'23 Copenhagen Congress, March 2, 2023 until the ECCO Congress in 2025. (Note: 2 years President-Elect followed by 2 years as President and 2 years as Past-President).

Nomination process:

The candidate can be nominated by any Regular Member and requires two seconders. Both the proposer and seconders can be any Regular Member of ECCO or any Y-ECCO Member in good standing, except members of the Governing Board. The nominee, nominator and seconders must all be from different nations.
