Call for next ECCO Scientific Workshop topic

Dear ECCO Friends,

SciCom is launching its tenth Scientific Workshop (SWS) and a new topic needs to be selected.

With a biennial open call for topics, ECCO Scientific Workshops focus on a key, unanswered question in the field of IBD, bringing together multiple working groups, each exploring different aspects of the topic.

Over the course of two years, these groups systematically evaluate existing evidence, identify research gaps, and set priorities for - potential and external - future studies.

If you have a topic to propose, **please submit a title and 100-word supporting statement to the ECCO Office** via the online submission page: "[Scientific Workshop 10: Call for topics](#)" by **May 31, 2025**.

One topic will be selected.

The organisation of the workshop will be:

1. Call for topics: **April 30, 2025**.
2. Deadline for proposals: **May 31, 2025**.
3. Decision on the topic by SciCom: **June 30, 2025** followed by the selection of the Coordinators (up to four members including the proposer of the topic, one young clinician scientist, and one member representing SciCom).
4. Online meeting of the Coordinators **September/October, 2025**. Definition of key areas of interest and focus of the scientific workshop.
5. Open call for participants by end of **November 2025**.
6. Selection of participants and working group leaders by end of **December 2025** by Coordinators. Distribution of allocated questions to the participants by the group leaders.
7. SW10 Meeting at ECCO'26 in **February 2026**: F2F kick-off meeting.
8. Meetings organised within groups by Workgroup leaders.
9. Online finalisation meeting in **October/ September 2026**, discussing the outcome and manuscripts.
10. Submit abstract to ECCO'27 Congress by **November 2026** deadline.
11. End of **January 2027**: Deadline for submission of the last Scientific Workshop manuscript (in agreement with Editor-in-Chief of JCC) via ECCO Office.
