



## NOTICE OF FORTHCOMING Y-ECCO ELECTIONS

Dear Colleagues in IBD!

Notice is hereby given that the following positions on the Young ECCO Committee (Y-ECCO) are open for election:

### **2 or 3 Y-ECCO Members 2027-2030**

#### **Mission of Y-ECCO:**

- Maintain friendship and collaboration between young clinicians and scientists.
- Encourage scientific and clinical development to support continuing involvement in ECCO Activities.
- Participate in the educational and scientific activities.
- Act as a platform for all young clinicians and scientists.

#### **Eligibility:**

Applicants have to be established specialists in the area of IBD who are ECCO Regular Members of good standing (=ECCO Members 2026) under the age of 35. However, they cannot apply for a term overlapping with a term of another Committee Member from the same institution.

A candidate can only serve on max 3 ECCO Committees incl. Y-ECCO (consecutively or with a break in between).

Each Committee may devote 1 position within the Committee to a Non-European ECCO Regular Member. Please note that this candidate may not become Committee Chair nor Governing Board Member. Reimbursements remain at the European level.

#### **Election criteria:**

- Achievement and experience in the field of IBD (publications, scientific initiatives, project development).



- Declaration of intent including a statement of the contribution that the candidate will bring to the Committee, academic expertise, team spirit, commitment, familiarity with ECCO, prior contribution to ECCO and future potential.
- Profile: This is why scores are not the only consideration of every Committee. Other important factors that have to be considered during the election process are regional and gender diversity, institutional affiliation within the Committee, age.

### **Term of office:**

The Committee Membership lasts 3 years, it starts at the ECCO'27 Copenhagen Congress on March 4, 2027 and ends in 2030.

### **Nomination process:**

A candidate may be proposed by an ECCO Member in good standing or self-nominated. Self-nominations need to be seconded by an ECCO Member in good standing. Forms for nominating candidates can be obtained from the ECCO Office or downloaded from the [ECCO Website](#).

### **Application documents:**

- a nomination form including a seconder
- a short CV
- a list of 10 best publications
- and a letter of intent, explaining the suitability for the position in question. Please note that applicants may apply for up to 2 positions in different Committees, however, the letter of intent needs to include justification as well as a clear statement of the first and second choice.
