

# Letter from the e-Learning Editor-in-Chief

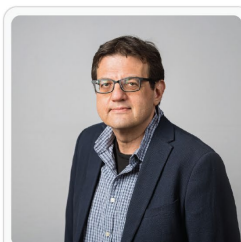
Dear ECCO Members and Colleagues,

It is an absolute pleasure to address you for the first time as the new ECCO e-Learning Editor-in-Chief.

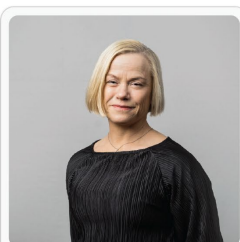
